



## CEO Malcolm P. Slatko to be honored with 2012 Spirit of Life Award at La Dolce Vita - The Sweet Life! Winter Gala

Come celebrate *La Dolce Vita – The Sweet Life!* with Seven Acres Jewish Senior Care Services on Saturday evening, February 4, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. in the ballroom of the Westin Galleria Hotel. The Italian-themed event will honor CEO Malcolm P. Slatko with the 2012 Spirit of Life Award for his twenty-five years of devotion to the elderly and disabled in the community. Festivities will begin with a cocktail party and silent auction followed by dinner, casino games, and dancing with the *Ricky Diaz Orchestra*.

Malcolm P. Slatko has been a practicing gerontologist affiliated with Seven Acres Jewish Senior Care Services for over three decades, serving as Chief Executive Officer for the past 25 years. He holds a Master's degree in Gerontology and long-term care administration from the Center for Studies in Aging in Cleveland, Ohio, and completed his residency there at the Menorah Park Jewish Home, returning to Texas to become administrator at the Dallas Home for Jewish Aged. In 1980, he came home to Houston, where he embarked upon his longstanding career at Seven Acres.

Malcolm is an adjunct professor at Baylor College of Medicine and founder and Chairman of the Board of the Caring Traditions Alliance, the first state managed care organization of its kind, serving over 3,000 indigent elderly and disabled persons. He has served on numerous Boards of Trustees in the health care and educational

fields, including the American Association of Jewish Aging Services (AJAS) and the Texas Association of Homes and Services for the Aging (TAHSA). Malcolm also served on the boards of the Robert M. Beren Academy, TORCH, and the Houston Area Parkinson's Society. He and his wife, Leslie, were also the founders and original board members of the Monarch School, which serves children with learning differences.

Both AJAS and TAHSA honored him with humanitarian and community service awards for his life-saving efforts in creating the largest emergency triage effort in the history of the Texas Medical Center for the elderly who fled New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina. Other honors he has received

include the AJAS Executive of the Year and the Hans Mayer Jewish Communal Professional Award from the Jewish Federation of Greater Houston.

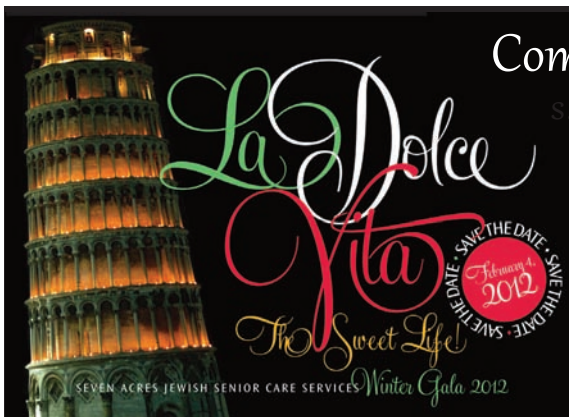
Malcolm is one of the longest practicing Jewish community executives in Houston. A noted author, lecturer, and consultant to numerous elder care organizations across the country, he is considered a national expert in health care policy, education, and fund development activities and has raised millions of dollars to benefit the Houston's Jewish elderly and disabled. Malcolm and Leslie reside in Bellaire, Texas and have two children--Lauren, of Austin, Texas, and Chaim, of Monsey, New York.

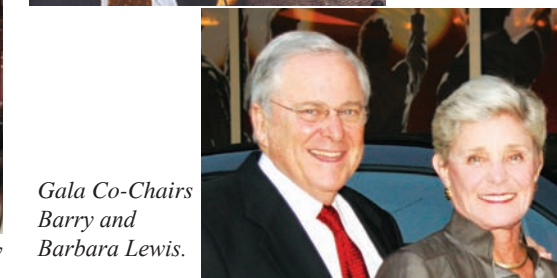

## Seven Acres and Medallion Residents Experience High Holiday Tradition of Visiting Cemeteries to Honor Loved Ones

“This has never happened before but it probably should have,” remarked Houston Jewish Funerals Director Jeff Friedman as he recounted how, together with a group of dedicated individuals, he and Seven Acres Chaplain Rabbi Mark Urkowitz were able to coordinate several trips to local Jewish cemeteries for residents of Seven Acres and The Medallion who wished to visit the graves of their loved ones during the High Holidays.

“Once I was contacted by Rabbi Urkowitz, a lot of people worked quickly together to make this happen. The project took on so many facets. We sent each synagogue a list of names of the deceased and almost immediately the staffs sent back a list telling us where their graves were located in each cemetery,” Friedman continued. “Jose Ramirez, the caretaker for all the Jewish cemeteries, was terrific and laid out small flags to help the Seven Acres staff find each grave. Everyone thought this was so important that they all did their part and in just a matter of a few days. It is a small thing but meaningful for the residents to be able to visit their loved ones.”

Seven Acres staff worked together to make this a significant event for the residents who participated. At this point in their lives, so many elderly want to feel close to departed parents, a spouse or children. They have a need to visit a grave and spiritually communicate with God and their loved ones. Visiting their parents’ graves enables them to perform the mitzvah of honoring their parents, even in death.

On the day of each trip, residents gathered in the lobbies of both The Medallion and Seven Acres to wait their turn to be helped onto the Seven Acres bus. Most took advantage of using the motorized lift and then were helped to their seats or had their wheelchairs strapped into place by bus driver Lawrence Johnson.

Upon arrival at the cemeteries, Johnson pulled the bus up as close as he could to each grave that was marked with a small red flag. Because many of the residents cannot walk upon the rocky terrain with walkers and wheelchairs, they remained on the bus and looked out the window as Rabbi Urkowitz went over to the grave and recited a memorial prayer and placed stones on the headstone. Others were able to descend from the bus and walk to the gravesite with the rabbi.

The residents were very grateful for the visit. Many thanked the Rabbi and the staff profusely for the chance to visit a loved one’s grave. They told them that they had no way of going before, and it has been many years since someone could take them. This was a very satisfying experience for staff and residents alike.

“I brought a beautiful seashell from Kauai, Hawaii for the rabbi to place on my husband’s grave,” remarked Shirley Perlman. “Our son lives there and we visited the islands often. It was my husband’s favorite place, so I always bring my Hawaiian shells when I visit his grave. The rabbi did a beautiful job.”

Medallion resident Sam Feldt visited the grave of his late wife who had been both a resident and volunteer at Seven Acres. “This was very nice, very thoughtful,” he stated.

“Everyone who heard about the program was very touched by it, and we had wonderful feedback from the community at large. The residents really appreciated it,” said Rabbi Mark Urkowitz.

## Photography Exhibit at Seven Acres Spreads Awareness of Alzheimer’s Disease

These are the words from a poem entitled “Nature’s Glory: To Live Again” by Joyce Waite. Ms. Waite is a member of “Discovering Connections”, a group of individuals who regularly participate in a support group for those in the early stages of Alzheimer’s disease. The group is supported, in part, by a grant from the Alzheimer’s Association.

Ms. Waite’s poem accompanied a photograph she took that captured a close-up shot of beautiful green reeds and wildflowers in a meadow and was one in a group of nineteen photos that appeared in an exhibition that took place at Seven Acres on October 16. The exhibition, called “Discovering Creativity”, was sponsored by the Houston and Southeast Texas chapter of the Alzheimer’s Association and co-hosted by Seven Acres and The Medallion.

“Our participants were given disposable cameras and set free to capture whatever images they pleased; many opted for those associated with strong memories,” remarked Teri Miller, an Occupational Therapist and Early Stage Program Manager for the Alzheimer’s Association Houston and Southeast Texas Chapter. “After collecting the images, the ‘Discovering Connections’ members met to share their artwork, collaborate about ideas for clever titles and vote on which pieces should be displayed in the exhibit. They also wrote ekphrastic poetry, a style of poetry about another art form, to reflect on their thoughts on each image. In the process, many discovered talents they didn’t know they had. As this exhibit illustrates, given the opportunity, individuals in the early stages of the disease can be creative and insightful.”

As in many formal photo exhibits, several of the photographers

were on hand to speak with the guests and answer questions. Most were joined by their family members, many of whom also participate in the care partners section of “Discovering Connections” where they gain strategies for reducing stress and develop personal support networks.

“The ‘Discovering Creativity’ exhibit, is a reminder to senior citizens, care partners and family members to be aware of the signs of Alzheimer’s and to also know that a diagnosis does not have to be so foreboding,” remarked Noga Tobias, Corporate Outreach Coordinator for the Association’s Houston chapter, who helped to organize the Seven Acres and Medallion exhibit. “We often tend to dismiss people with Alzheimer’s as people who are no longer able to think and communicate. We hope that people will gather from it is that people with Alzheimer’s are still productive and can still contribute to society.”

generous supporter of Seven Acres, the late Lou Lewis believed that society achieves its highest goals through education and service. The Lou Lewis Memorial Fund, which also provides educational scholarships to nursing personnel in gerontology, was established by his wife Rosetta and sons Barry and Eugene Lewis to perpetuate this philosophy.

## Residents From the Former Soviet Union Receive Weekly Newsletter in Russian

Each week Seven Acres residents receive a copy of an in-house newsletter called *Residents Speaks*. Edited by resident Leon Sherman, it is a compilation consisting of interviews with residents and staff, a column entitled, "This Week in Jewish History", a Yiddish column, a section entitled "Around Our Home", several word games, a listing of all the birthdays for the week, an events calendar and the complete menu for the week. The newsletter is printed with the assistance of the Seven Acres activity department and is a lifeline for the residents to keep up with what is happening at the "Home".

Seven Acres now publishes a version of the *Residents Speaks* in Russian for the approximately twenty Russian speaking residents, most of whom read little or no English. Family member Marina Lantsberg whose mother, Natalya Fertelmeister, is a resident of Seven Acres, initiated this project when she saw the need for a Russian translated version of the news at the facility. "I think, this is such a small contribution to the residents but if translating this newsletter could help a little bit to break a language barrier between the wonderful staff of Seven Acres and Russian residents, I'm really happy," she remarked.

The Russian *Residents Speaks* is a coordinated effort between Ms. Lantsberg, her mother-in-law and Sue Cororve, Director of Recreation and Volunteer Services at Seven Acres. "Not only is the goal of this project to help my mother and others like her who do not have adequate English speaking skills but I also involve my mother-in-law in this project. She is 80 years old, lives in Chicago, but is very lonely. I could have done the translation myself, but I decided that it would occupy her and give her something to do, too. So, every time Sue emails me the new weekly newsletter, I extract the pages that need to be translated and email them to my mother-in-law to Chicago. She does a translation and sends it back to me, then I do the formatting and editing. I also translate the weekly menu and then I email it all back to Sue."

"Many of these residents are members of families who immigrated to Houston from the Former Soviet Union as part of multi-generational families," remarked Ms. Cororve. "They may have arrived here when they were already in their sixties and never entered the workforce, communicating only with friends and family who spoke

Russian. This project got its start when Marina Lantsberg offered to make Russian language flash cards that the nursing and activities staff could use to communicate with residents with limited English speaking skills. It progressed to include translating the newsletter with the help of Marina's mother-in-law."

"How wonderful it is for our Russian speaking residents to be able to feel that they are a part of what is happening at Seven Acres," she continued. "Now, they feel more connected to what is going on at the Home. The Seven Acres staff and residents are so very grateful to Marina and her mother-in-law for providing this worthwhile service to those Russian residents who have difficulty reading our English language newsletter."

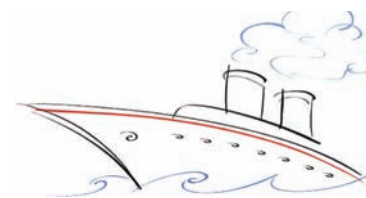
