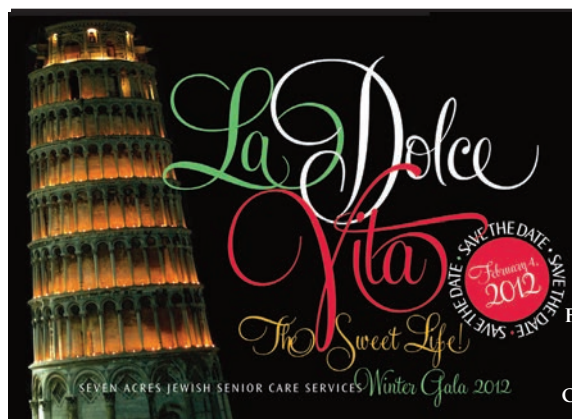

Dear Members of the Seven Acres Family,

In the original Godfather movie of some thirty plus years ago, Michael Corleone was forced to hide in Sicily, having gunned down a New York City police captain and a fellow Mafioso. While hiking one day, he encountered a young woman. He was in awe of her beauty, and something inside him told him she was the one, and he immediately wanted to marry her. Amazingly, he didn't even know her name. His armed guards explained that he had been hit by the "Thunderbolt." He married her. Unfortunately they did not live happily ever after.

In the coming weeks we will gather at our synagogues and temples for a Jewish Thunderbolt. It will not be for a beautiful woman. We will not need armed guards. It will be for Kol Nidre, the opening Yom Kippur service. I remember growing up listening to the adults say, "What time is Kol Nidre? How was the Cantor's Kol Nidre?" etc. I would venture a guess that 99% of those attending services have not given much thought to the content of Kol Nidre.

I do not think I would be going out on a limb to say that if we were to look closely at the text of Kol Nidre, the idea of the Jewish Thunderbolt would be furthest from our minds. Kol Nidre does not focus on our admission of mistakes. Kol Nidre does not discuss forgiveness, the central theme of Yom Kippur. Kol Nidre does not turn our attention to God.

What then is Kol Nidre? It is a technical formulation of Jewish law which annuls vows that we have or will assume. Nothing spiritual, nothing introspective, nothing earth shattering. As a matter of fact, throughout the middle ages, from Babylonia to western Europe, there were serious attempts to remove Kol Nidre from the Yom Kippur liturgy.

Despite its content, despite its history, Kol Nidre has assumed a larger than life imprint upon us. Why? What does Kol Nidre awaken within us that is so moving? Kol Nidre meets us head on, on a level which reaches into our innermost being. It awakens within us a Jewish spark, the Jewish Thunderbolt. We don't know why, we cannot explain it. Kol Nidre is beyond rational explanation.

Kol Nidre is a part of the total expression of each Jew's connection to his/her Judaism. This total Jewish experience is an encounter which we cannot explain. There is something inside us which brings each one of us to the Jewish Thunderbolt of Yom Kippur, a small part of the much larger picture of the total Jewish Thunderbolt encounter.

When we gather at our synagogues or temples on Friday evening, October 7, for the start of Yom Kippur, we will come together because of the special and unexplainable drive which tells each one of us this is the place to be, at this moment in our lives.

When we connect with our Jewish Thunderbolt, we figuratively marry it. But unlike Michael Corleone, we do live happily ever after. We have given meaning to our lives.

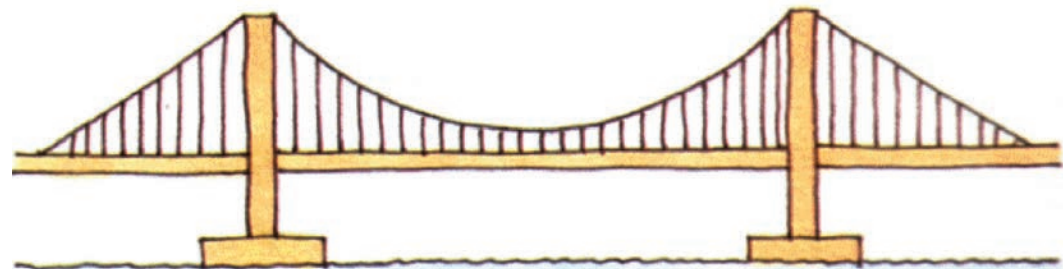
